The Aditya Birla Scholarship Programme is a fitting testament to the culture of excellence which he espoused in every step of life. And in doing so he made a mark on the world. Initiated in 1999, today we have a roster of 409 scholars, most of whom are engaged with marquee companies, leading consultancies and universities across the world.

The Aditya Birla Scholarships are awarded to outstanding students in the Engineering, Management and Law streams. The top 20 students from each of the premier institutes — IITs, BITS-Pilani; IIMs, XLRI-Jamshedpur, FMS-Delhi; NALSAR University of Law-Hyderabad, National Law School of India University-Bangalore, National Law University-Jodhpur, Gujarat National Law University-Gandhinagar and WBNU-Kolkata were evaluated. The process led to the shortlisting of 98 candidates from 423 students. These 98 aspirants, were interviewed in Mumbai on the 26th of September 2015 by an eminent jury. Of these, 45 students have been named "The Aditya Birla Scholars".
